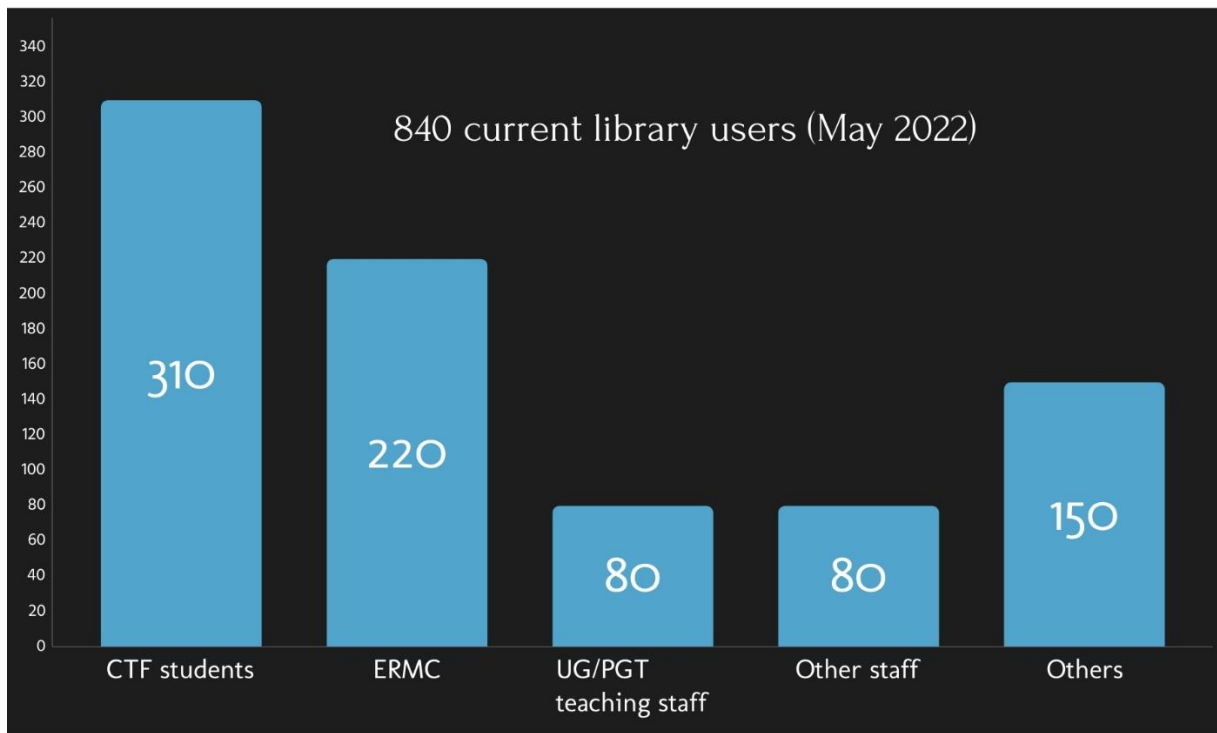




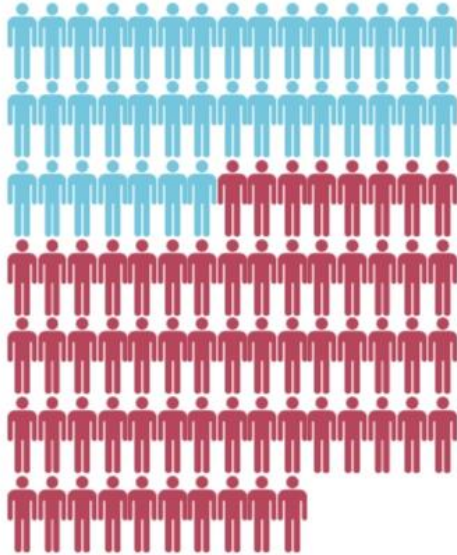

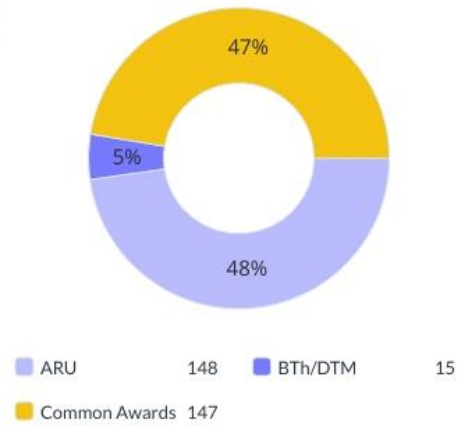


Federation's degree course students

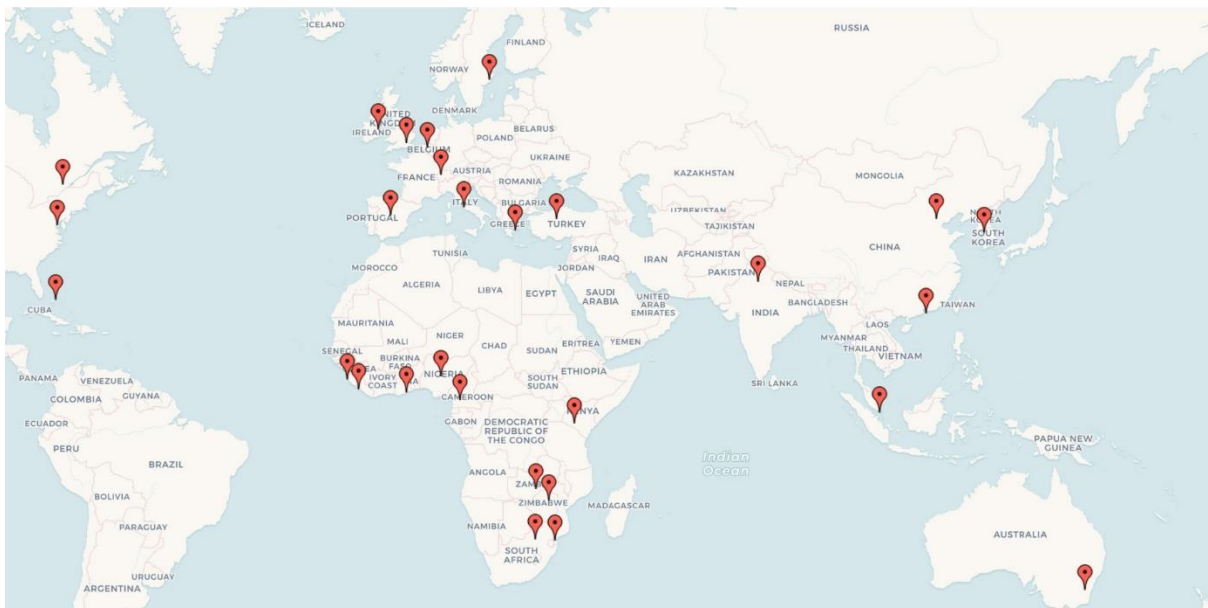
